Assignment

This Sabbath, we will have a special presentation consisting of an interactive discussion of **Ephesians 2:1-10** as we pause from our direct study of Revelation for a week to delve deeper into the message of Salvation we saw expressed in the messages to the Seven Churches. We will continue our direct study of the **Book of Revelation** with a message titled *History* in two weeks (Feb. 20).

- This week spend some time with **Ephesians 1:3-14 & 2:1-10**. Read it these verses through several times, perhaps even in a couple of different translations.
- What do you find comforting in these verses?
- Is there anything about these verses that make you uncomfortable? Why do you think that is?
- Who initiated the plan of salvation? Why is this important?
- What all was accomplished at the cross? What was accomplished at the resurrection?
- What does it feel like to be dead and doomed because of sin? How does it feel to be alive in Christ?
- What is the most important message you see in these verses?
- How will what you have learned affect the way you live your life? Why?
