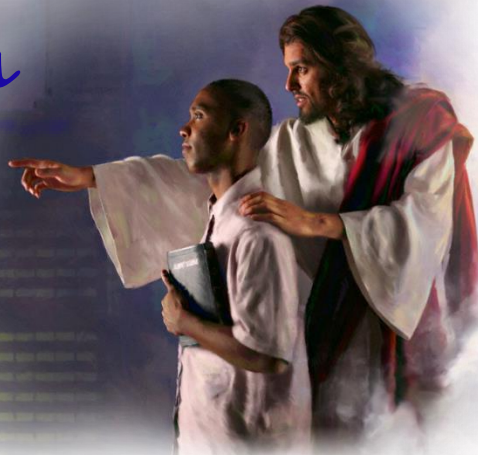


# Serving in China



## Assignment

You won't want to miss this opportunity to get a glimpse into how Christians are dealing with life there and even ask them some questions. We will continue our series on the Book of Revelation titled *Finding Jesus in Revelation (and Hearing His Voice)* with a message titled *History, Part 2* in two weeks (Mar. 6).

- This week spend some time with [Matthew 25:31-46](#), [John 13:34-35](#), & [James 4:17](#). Read these through several times, perhaps even in a couple of different translations.
- What do you find comforting in these verses?
- Is there anything about these verses that make you uncomfortable? Why do you think that is?
- What made the difference between the people who were saved and those who were lost in [Matthew 25](#)? Why is this important?
- What standard did Jesus give us for loving others? How much room does this leave for selfishness?
- The [10 Commandments](#) generally gives us things to not do – how do these passages move us beyond that?
- What is the most important message you see in these verses?
- How will what you have learned affect the way you live your life? Why?
